The Captain's meeting was brought to order by Aaron Mills. Meeting minutes from the last meeting were read and accepted.

A. Treasurer -Jessica Fulmer presented our financial report and it was accepted as read.

B. ADO rep. Ted Gay stated the regional qualifier would be held on Feb 21 at the Breakroom. Sign ups begin at 12:30 and play begins at 2:00. \$20.00 a person to enter the competition.

C. Secretary -Marty Foote had no news to report at this time.

D. Scorer -David Schuyler informed us the TDA Drop Box has been installed on the wall at the Breakroom. All Monies and paperwork is to be deposited in the box only, not given to anyone else.

E. Vice President -Rocky Conn had nothing to report.

F. PR –Tracie Hughes presented the final banquet proposals.

G. President –Aaron Mills had nothing at this time. We moved on to Old Business

Old Business:

First order of business addressed the **Jim Dickinson Award** for most improved players. This would be 1 man and 1 woman from each division. Koozies (\$5.00) each was suggested and also the option for a pin. Please think this over so we can have something ready for next season.

David made a proposal for the top 50% of each division be the only teams put in for the City Championship draw. This would start next season. It was not passed and it will remain as is. We voted on the \$150.00 a season that David is paid, he explained that the amount covers all his expenses so he will only receive that amount and not be paid for any additional supplies etc. This was voted on and accepted. He also wanted to change the current responsibility of home team turning in the score sheet. After much discussion it was voted to keep the way we have always had it. Home Team is responsible for turning in the score sheet.

Aaron Mills addressed the issue of the Double D's missing money for this season, The money was turned in to the bartender at the Cork n Bull. Since the Cork closed and we could not look for the money and they were not being cooperative with us we made the motion to let this team get their points back and that the TDA will pay for their registration fees. In the future do not hand your money to a bartender. Marty Foote suggested the members of the teams pay their captain and then in turn the Captain will turn in any checks and his personal check to include anyone that has paid him in cash. Rocky made the first motion to accept and Mark White seconded it.

David 's suggestion for giving high in and high outs for a set number for each division. A and B divisions would have to be 80 or above and C and D division would be set at 60 and above. This needs further discussion and would go into effect next season.

New Business:

Tracie presented the final proposals for the banquet and after the vote the Break Room won the vote with 1 for Harry's, 8 for VFW and 11 for the breakroom. The banquet will be Feb. 28th, starting with playoffs at 11:00 and the party approximately around 2:00. Please be sure not to start eating until the final matches are done. The winners and 2nd place are to be served before everyone else. First Place teams need to choose what they want and give to Tracie so she can give the order to Tami. If there are more than 30 people for the blind draw it will be single elimination. Takes way too long for double.

Jessica informed us that we needed to order more 2nd place pins and also get a price for 3 part score sheets so each captain has a copy and the original will be turned in. This helps if we have a team who lost the score sheet before weekly standings were made. General vote was that Jessica could order pins and score sheets if she could find a reasonable price. **Remember that next season the score sheet changes and one of the 501 singles will become doubles.**

.We have reimbursed David \$115.00 for his fees for the last regional. He represented the TDA so we needed to reimburse.

Dave Channel requested that the notice THE TDA DROP BOX IS LOCATED AT THE BREAKROOM. Put this in the packages instruction page.

Mike Novak made a proposal to change the ruling of a maximum of 8 players to a team. They have several shift workers on their team and several could be working nights on Wed. They all want to play on their team but would like a little lea way. Discuss this with your teams. Don't think the rule would have to be changed but we could agree to this particular team or those in the future to be accepted. This does not mean everyone can do this. You need to discuss these issues with your Board Members before you do anything other than the normal 8 to a team.

Smooth made a suggestion that the TDA use funds to help fund/partner with, the SRDA in co-sponsoring the Garden City Classic. There was lots of discussion and I think the final statement was this would not be possible this year since the tournament is March 6,7,and 8th. This would be a vote on a substantial amount of money and the entire league would have to vote on it. Marty Foote suggested that David have Mandy set up a presentation of how the existing tournament financially is done. We would like to see their financial status of profit and loss from the past tournaments that have been held. That way we could determine if our investment would be of profit for the TDA. Remember that money is all the TDA's members and how many of those members would be willing to play or for us to use the money for this at this time. We will sponsor boards as we have in the past. In the meantime talk to your teams and get some feed back.

Team Captains, please put signs up in your Bars that the drop box is at the Breakroom.

General Discussions were open at this time. More discussion on the Tournament partnering up was done amongst attendees.

Adjournment was then made. David brought his laptop so that those that wanted to see how the program works for the blind draw picks for playoffs. He shuffled the draw 4 times and the brackets came up at that time. He stated he would post them on site as soon as he placed the bars they would play out of. Since the closing of the Cork many things have been shuffled around.

Everyone then moved into the bar or stayed for a while to talk or play some darts. Thank you.
